

Appendix B: Questions for Children

In our questioning and even in our tone we ought to show compassion and a genuine love for our young brothers and sisters in Christ.

Prayer

- Do you have your own time for personal devotions? What time of the day do you do this? What do you understand by devotions?
- When you are in public do you pray before you eat your food? Why is this important?
- Do you pray for forgiveness of your sins? Do you mention specific sins?
- Do you pray for those who are in authority over you (your parents, teachers, office-bearers, government)?
- What does it mean for you to pray, “lead us not into temptation?” Do you think about praying before you go out with your friends?

On being a Christian

- How can you confess your faith at school or in the place where you are working?
- Do you think the way you dress has anything to do with your Christian conduct? How? What about your choice of music?
- How familiar are you with what is going on in the church and in the world?
- When do you know that you are ready to publicly profess your faith?
- How would you react if someone in the church wants you to do something you know is wrong and displeases the Lord?
- What is the proper manner of starting a relationship with a boy or girl? Are such issues discussed with your parents? Do you know what it means to live in the Lord and to marry in the Lord?
